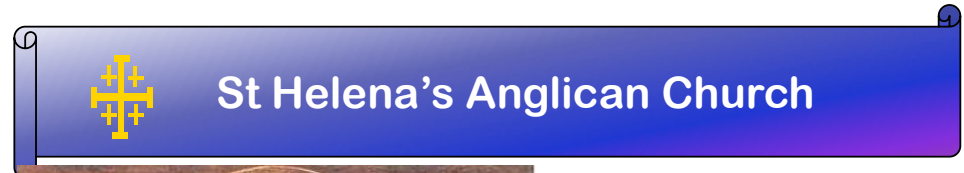

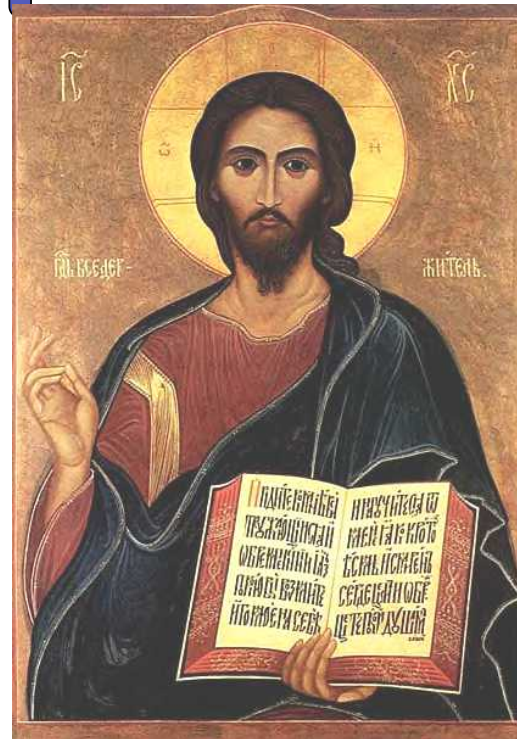
### Post Communion Prayer
