Good morning and a Happy and Prosperous New Year to all. Yesterday was the celebration of the Epiphany and our hymns this morning reflect that celebration.

During 2017, as a Church we tried to build our community and also to make an impact on the wider community in and around Larnaca. Hopefully, we will be able to continue in the same vein during 2018, trying to grow ourselves both in terms of numbers of congregation and also spiritually.

We will continue with our regular weekly Eucharist services each Sunday at 9.30am. Then this month we have our Quiet Service at 11am on 25th January. We also have our monthly Book Sales on the last Wednesday, recommencing on 31st January. Our Luncheon Club will also resume on 14th February. (The first Wednesday when it would normally be held clashes with the Diocesan Synod.)

As an experiment, last week we begun the second phase ‘Grow’ of the relatively new Pilgrim Course, which is the next generation of spirituality development leading on from the well-known Alpha course. The Pilgrim course is in two phases, the first of which (‘Follow’) is designed for those seeking to know more about God, whilst the second phase is for those who are already committed Christians, but who wish to develop further their individual spirituality. I’m sure that it will be an interesting journey for all those involved.
