Looking Forward –

Following last week's Council Meeting a number of important decisions have been reached. Council agreed to go ahead with the reshaping of the north west corner of the church, to include a new fully accessible toilet, and a more efficient vestry. Work should begin in late August and be completed by early September. While the work is in progress the church will continue in use. Toilet facilities will be available in the two ground floor toilets in our shop next door.

The last Sunday in September we shall observe as a 'Back to Church' Sunday. That means that we shall use the occasion to invite friends along to experience our church service. This will be the first of four services we shall hold each year that are non-eucharistic. Each will be held on the fifth Sunday of the month when that occurs.

In order to comply with the law on privacy of data, in a way that safeguards our identity as a prayerful community, we shall, in future, not publish the name of those for who we are asked to pray in our pew sheet, which can reach a wide audience. Rather we shall list them in our church prayer corner where we can light candles, mention names in 'live' public intercession, and add or remove names as presently. This will actually give a greater presence to our prayer corner. It may be that we shall be able to publish the more general diocesan prayer calendar in the pew sheet, which might make it more immediate than it now is.

The full details of the meeting are in the Minutes, available at the back of the church, which also include the dates on which the shop will close for the Summer holiday.
