Today, John is celebrating in St Andrew's Church, Kyrenia as the parish priest there is on extended sick leave. I will be celebrating today, but we are again joined by Peter Day on the final Sunday of his placement with us in preparation for his ordination as a Deacon on 7th July. Peter will lead the liturgy of the Word this morning.

All the parishes on the island were represented at a meeting last Tuesday to discuss our island-wide wedding ministry. It was interesting to gain different viewpoints from the other parishes and from the Diocese, and also to see where the Cyprus Archdeaconry may be able to develop a more joined-up approach to how we manage weddings across the island and, indeed, to try to publicise the availability of Cyprus Church weddings more widely, especially in the UK wedding exhibitions.

On Thursday at 2pm, there will be the fifth session (of six) of the Pilgrim course, here in Church. This course seeks to help develop individual spirituality and to give an insight into how we can connect personally with God. In particular during this group of sessions, we are looking at our active participation in the Eucharist and what that may mean for us all from a spiritual perspective.
