## **Looking Forward –**

*It was good to witness Fr Geoff's Graduation last Monday, and good to see the parish represented. The next Diocesan occasion in the cathedral is on July 7<sup>th</sup> when Peter Day and Justin Arnott will be ordained as Deacons. All are welcome to that service also. Next week I shall be at an ordination service at St David's Cathedral in Wales to be one of those laying hands on one of our former swallows, Rev'd Gaynor Ford. I shall take St Helena's good wishes. I also have the privilege of preaching at her first Eucharist, so Fr Geoff will be in charge here next Sunday.*

*GDPR are initials which have become embedded in our corporate consciousness over the last few weeks. Fr Geoff is guiding our response to the changes in data law. We intend to introduce new practices in a measured way. This means that those on the Electoral Roll need to sign an additional form at the moment, also those who are part of our wider family and whose contact details we hold, need to give us written permission to contact them. The most controversial area is the prayer corner. It seems that complete adherence to the new law would have repercussions on whom we may pray for publicly. Our strong feeling is that we do need to be disciplined in the way we share information about those who need our prayers, but also that those prayers should not be withheld when we know the people involved would want us to pray, simply because we have not completed the paperwork.*

*Our final book sale before the Summer begins in earnest will be on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> June. I shall be taking the service at St George's in the Troodos on 1st July and, as ever, it would be really good to have some congregation members from St Helena's there. The service begins at 4pm. Come and make an afternoon of it.*
