Looking Forward –

The Council Meeting last week was concerned about situations vacant. We need a new treasurer following Jan's notice of resignation. Jan has done a great job for a number of years and we owe it to her for someone else to step up to the mark. We also owe it to the Church as a whole to have someone who will look after our money competently, as Jan has, and will be able to keep the Council fully informed about our financial state. This does not have to be someone who is based here permanently. Other parishes manage with a 'swallow' treasurer, supported by residents prepared to physically count collections and take money to the bank and so on, which we do have.

There will also be a vacancy for a Weddings Coordinator. We do not have many weddings in St Helena's but when we do, they are well administered and that is really important. The person appointed will, for a brief moment, play an important role in the life of couples. Let me know if this could be you.

We have vacancies for more helpers in the Perivolia shop, following the loss of some key people who have moved away. Please see Jean if you can help.

Finally, in the second half of next year, there will be a vacancy for Chaplain here, when I reach the point at which the rules say I must retire. The Wardens have been in touch with the Bishop about this and a process is in place. The appointment will be made in the same way that I was appointed, with the Bishop presenting a preferred candidate to Parish selectors. The appointee will have a similar job to my present one. He will be Archdeacon in Cyprus, but he will have a different role with regard to the Diocese as a whole.

I am totally focussed on doing the jobs I do until the day I go, which is a considerable time away, and I don't really want this to become a cause of anxiety or a matter of extended conversation.
