Looking Forward –

Rogation Sunday is the ancient (British) term for the Sunday on which the planted crops were blessed. It's a Sunday which, for that reason also is associated with Prayer and in some places is actually called Prayer Sunday, because prayers are a bit like seeds, planted in hope that the fruit will come. There are lots of local customs for Rogation Sunday in the UK. One is 'beating the bounds,' where congregations walk the perimeters of the parish, to remind them of the sense of earthly place that they inhabit and pray for. Others have developed the theme to think of the day as Industrial Sunday or Fishermen's Sunday.

This week we have a selection conference in the Gulf which I must attend, and next Sunday I shall be making a farewell visit to Kyrenia so Fr Geoff will be standing in for most of that period. I shall be back with you on June 9th, the Day of Pentecost. Later that day I shall be going with Sue to the UK in the hope that we can settle her there prior to our move; so that will effectively be her last Sunday in St Helena's, though it would confuse her for people to remark on it. Please continue to remember her in your prayers.
