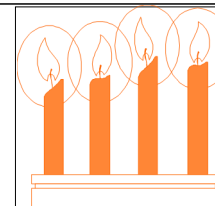

CANDLEMAS: The End Of The Christmas and Epiphany Season.

The Presentation of Christ in the Temple. Mary and Joseph took the baby Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem forty days after his birth to dedicate him to God, in keeping with Jewish law. Upon bringing Jesus to the temple, the family encountered Simeon; the gospel records that Simeon had been promised "he should not see death before he had seen the Messiah of the Lord." (Luke 2: 26). Simeon prayed the prayer that would become known as the Nunc Dimittis, or Canticle of Simeon, and prophesied regarding Jesus. The prophetess Anna was also in the Temple, and offered prayers and praise to God for Jesus. Traditionally Candlemas was the last feast in the Christian year that was dated by reference to Christmas. **Candlemas marked the end of the Christmas and Epiphany season.** The term "Candlemas" refers to the practice whereby a priest on February 2nd would bless the candles to be used in church that year with an aspergillum. Candles to be used in the home were also blessed.

The Light of Christ has come into the world.

Nunc Dimittis:

Lord, now you let your servant go in peace; Your word has been fulfilled. My eyes have seen the salvation You have prepared in the sight of every people, A light to reveal you to the nations and the glory of your people, Israel. Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Ghost as it was in the beginning is now and ever shall be world without end. **Amen.**
