in the centre of Larnaca, Cyprus.**



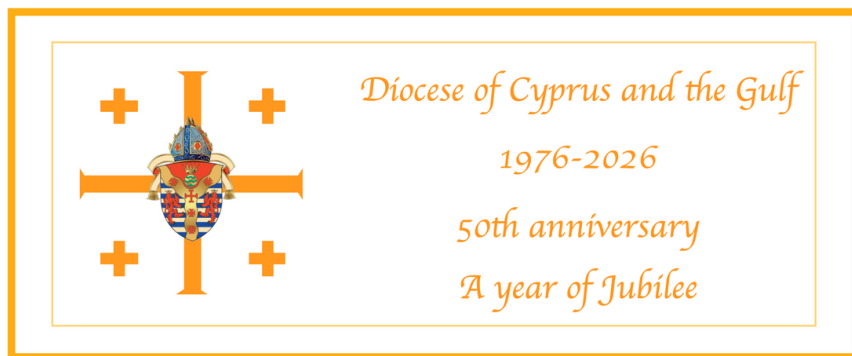
From 1907 Christian worship has been offered from our premises.
