in the centre of Larnaca, Cyprus.**



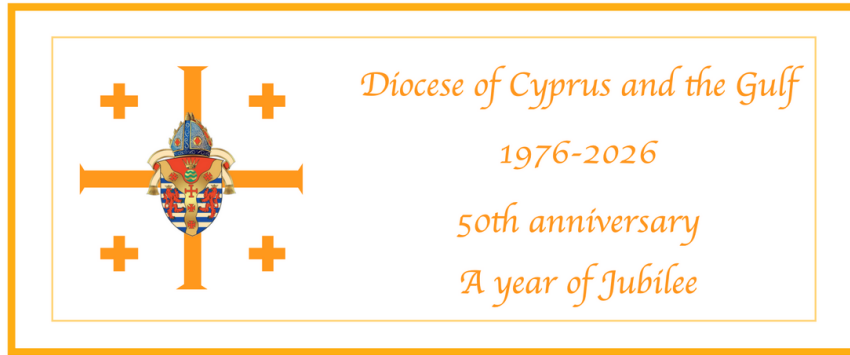
