Bishop Michael ... PILGRIM VISIT TO TURKEY, AUTUMN 2027

Bishop Michael Lewis, former Diocesan Bishop, is planning a pilgrimage to the locations of the **Seven Churches of the Book of Revelation** in Asia Minor, now western Turkey. It will be an eight-day, seven-night tour, from 6th to 13th October 2027. It will begin in Izmir. Those flying from the UK will travel from Stansted.

Those travelling from other countries who may find it convenient to arrange their own flights to Izmir are welcome to do so. Prices are quoted for both options. As well as featuring the towns, some populated and some ruined, whose early Christian congregations are addressed by the author of the last book of the Bible, the pilgrimage will call at Miletus, where St Paul bade a powerful farewell to the elders of the church of Ephesus, and Hierapolis, where the apostle Philip is remembered. Nearby and also on the programme are the spectacular off-white travertine mineral formations of Pamukkale. Also in the itinerary will be the great city of Aphrodisias and the intriguing site of Priene on a scenic hillside. Bishop Michael invites expressions of interest. All who contact him will receive a brochure with full details.
